

YR11's - Pupils vs Teachers Basketball



HPQ

Congratulations to 32 of our Year 9's who have completed their Higher Project Qualifications!

This HPQ is a GCSE standard qualification in which pupils research and produce a project on any subject of their choosing. This qualification is the equivalent of half a GCSE.

There was a vast range of subjects explored - from Fast Fashion to Dissociative Identity Disorder. Pupils learnt key skills such as: referencing, ethical procedures, how to conduct primary research and the perils of plagiarism.

Not only did they research and write their project, but they also had to present a summary of their findings and their research methods to their peers and teachers at the end of the project.

All these pupils volunteered to take part in the HPQ programme and attended regular sessions after school as part of our clubs and co-curricular programme.

A celebratory lunch next half term has been organised by the English Department, to celebrate their success and perseverance. Well done !
