




## Why is knowledge important?

#### Knowledge Organiser


- Contains basic knowledge, not everything
- Two parts knowledge base and knowledge builder




#### What do pupils think?

3.62 Average Rating







## How can you help your child?


- Watch the short video

- Test them (create flashcards) or just ask them questions

#### Why is testing important?

- 1. Improved memory
- 2. More confident learner
- 3. Reduces exam nerves
- 4. Enhances memory during stressful situations
- 5. Helps you identify what you do not know
- 6. One of the most effective revision strategies

#### THE GROUND RULES

- Social media use monitor and use carefully




#### WHY IS ATTENDANCE IMPORTANT?

- Central to raising standards in education and ensuring all pupils can fulfil their potential is an assumption so widely understood that it is insufficiently stated – pupils need to attend school regularly to benefit from their education.
- Missing out on lessons leaves children vulnerable to falling behind.
   Children with poor attendance tend to achieve less in secondary school.

#### REMINDERS ABOUT ATTENDANCE

We all feel in our comfort zone if our child is achieving a high percentage in tests/assessments and 80% in a test is generally excellent news! The danger is that we may feel the same way about attendance until it is explained!

If a child has an attendance percentage of 80%, then this is equivalent to missing a whole day of school every single week.

If a child has an attendance percentage of 80% each year from Year 7 to Year 11, then this is equivalent to missing an entire year of school.



#### REMINDERS ABOUT ATTENDANCE

One year in school is the same as 950 one hour lessons.

Five years in school is the same as 4750 one hour lessons.

Five years of school comes down to **one** set of grades on **one** sheet of paper in an envelope.
